Overview

How long does it stay in place?

The reservoir can remain for months or years, depending on treatment needs. When it is no longer necessary, it can be removed through a surgical procedure. Families who have already been through the process often share strategies that make a big difference in daily. An Ommaya reservoir (also known as an intraventricular reservoir) allows your care team to take samples of cerebrospinal fluid and give medicines through the reservoir. The reservoir is placed under your scalp and the small tube is put into a space in your brain called a ventricle.

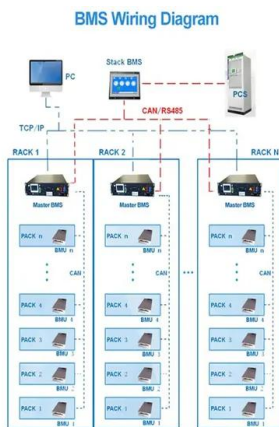

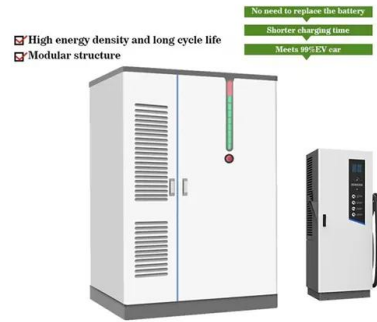
