

# How long does it take for urine retention to recover

Most patients begin noticing improvements in their urinary retention symptoms within 4-6 weeks of starting pelvic floor physical therapy, with significant progress typically occurring over 8-12 weeks. This care sheet gives you a general idea about how long it will take for you to recover. What is urinary retention?

Urinary retention is a condition where your bladder doesn't empty all the way or at all when you urinate (pee). This bladder dysfunction can develop suddenly as an acute condition requiring immediate medical attention, or gradually over time as a chronic.

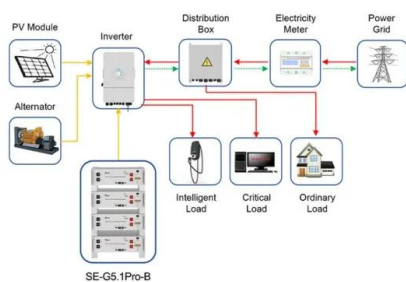

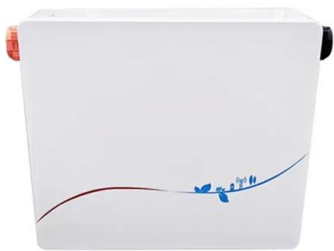
