

How much can the national reserve earn every year



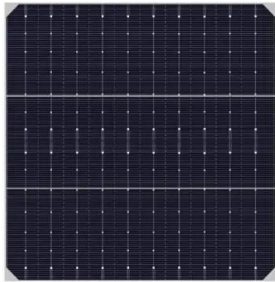


Overview

The national reserve's potential earnings can be categorized into several aspects: 1. Interest-bearing assets contribute significantly to income, as reserves typically hold government bonds or other fixed-income securities that yield regular. The pay rate will depend on your rank and the number of years you've been enlisted, but more time in service can mean more pay. As an active duty soldier, you can receive base pay, BAH (Basic Allowance for Housing), and other types of payments and allowances.

Reserve Retirement Pay Overview

A typical reservist year of 48 unit drill periods (24 days), a 15-day AT, and 15 membership points adds up to 78 retirement points, well above the 50 points needed for a "good year"

How Much Do the Reserves Get Paid a Month?

Reservists typically commit to one weekend of drill each month and two weeks of annual training each year. These drill periods and trainings are crucial because that's when reservists hone their skills and ...

Reserve Retirement Pay Overview

15 points per year as a member of the Reserve, National Guard, or IRR Each paid drill period
Typical 2-day unit drill weekend is 4 pay periods and 4 points Unpaid additional drill (Points Only)



Overview of Reserve Component Compensation and Benefits

Bonus for agreeing to remain on active duty in a regular component or serve in an active status in a reserve component for at least one year
Maximum bonus: \$25K for each 12-month period
