

Japan's solar container shutdown





Overview

Japan is set to impose stricter environmental oversight on future large-scale solar projects. The government may also discontinue financial support under its feed-in tariff and feed-in premium schemes for large, ground-mounted solar beginning April 2027. Solar panels are seen near the Kushiro Wetlands in Kushiro, Hokkaido, in October. The proposal comes as Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi — who is also head of the Liberal Democratic Party — prioritizes energy.
