

State-owned forest land can be transferred





Overview

In any case where State-owned or privately owned land is completely surrounded by national forest lands within areas designated by this chapter as wilderness, such State or private owner shall be given such rights as may be necessary to assure adequate access to. States can obtain authority to own and manage federal lands within their borders only by federal, not state, law. Within the Department of Environmental Protection, the State Parks, Forest Service, Forest Fire Service, Natural Lands Management and State Park Police work together to provide equitable and responsible access to the state's natural, historic and recreational resources and through the. Such parcels must meet one of three criteria: Disposing of them will serve important public objectives, such as community expansion or economic development. 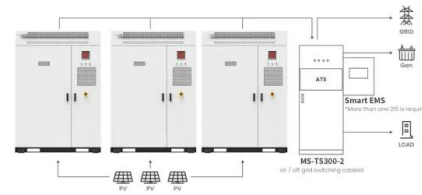
